City Wide Clean-Up Day has been scheduled for Saturday, July 15th



Report Street Light Outages

Call City Hall to report any street light outage or street light problem (including: light out, light on during the day, light going on and off, dim light, etc.).



Since 1970, the City of St. Clair has contracted with the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Dept. for police protection.

Call 911 to report any police, fire or medical emergency or when witnessing/observing any unusual or suspicious person, activity or behavior.

If in doubt as to whether a situation warrants a 911 call ... be on the safe side and make the call!
