Any eligible voter can vote early with an Absentee Ballot!


Absentee Ballot Applications and information may be found on the MN VOTES website or by calling the Blue Earth County Elections Dept. at 507-304-4341.

- On the Monday, November 5th until 5 pm

LEAVES & GRASS CLIPPINGS



Residents are asked not to rake leaves or mow grass clippings into the street, curb or gutter. Storm sewers are not designed to handle quantities of leaves, grass clippings and other yard debris. During a rainstorm, leaves, grass clippings and other yard debris can quickly plug storm drains and cause clogged pipes, back-ups and other problems.



RECREATIONAL CAMPFIRE

A 3' X 3' recreational campfire using clean, dry, untreated wood is the only type of burning permitted in St. Clair. Burning leaves, grass, waste materials, construction debris and any materials other than clean, dry, untreated wood is PROHIBITED.
