NOTICE OF FILING AFFIDAVITS OF CANDIDACY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Municipal Election for the City of St. Clair will be held in conjunction with the General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. The following City Council seats will be on the General Election ballot:

MAYOR	1 position 2 year term (Jan. 2021 – Dec. 2022)
CITY COUNCIL	2 positions 4 year term (Jan. 2021 – Dec. 2024)

The period for filing Affidavits of Candidacy begins on Tuesday, July 28, 2020 and ends at 5:00 pm on Tuesday, August 11, 2020. Affidavits of Candidacy may be filed in-person with the City Clerk at the St. Clair City Hall, 304 Main Street West, St. Clair, Minnesota. Affidavits of Candidacy may also be filed by email, mail or drop-box by contacting the City Clerk at (507)245-3494 or via email at citystc@hickorytech.net.

Candidates must file an Affidavit of Candidacy form and pay a \$2.00 filing fee with the City Clerk.

Individuals filing for an elective office must be eligible to vote, must be 21 years of age or older upon assuming office, must be a resident of the City of St. Clair for at least 30 days before the General Election, and must have no other Affidavit of Candidacy on file for any other elected office.

Candidates may withdraw their names from consideration until 5:00 pm on Thursday, August 13, 2020. Filing fees are not refundable.



The City has contracted with KLM Engineering for the cleaning and refurbishing of the interior of the City water tower.

The cleaning is expected to begin in August, with completion within 2 to 3 weeks.

During the cleaning process residents may experience discolored water and low water pressure, this is normal and in no way affects the water quality.

Water service will continue as usual for the duration of the cleaning; however the water tower will be empty throughout the cleaning process (the City will not have any water storage during this time). For this reason, residents are asked to limit outdoor water use especially sprinklers, pool filling and other activities that require using large amounts of water.
