

CITY OF ST. CLAIR FILL/EXCAVATE/GRADE PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

If approved, the Fill/Excavate/Grade Permit must comply with the following requirements:

COMPLETION DATE: Project must be completed 90 days from the date of permit issuance.

HOURS OF OPERATION: Project activities shall be limited to 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.

TYPE OF MATERIAL: Appropriate fill material must be used, no garbage, animal or vegetable waste, contaminants, chemicals, poisons, decayed material, filth, sewer or biologically dangerous materials.

OTHER PERMIT CONDITIONS:

- Project activities must be kept within the limits of the permit.
- Provide adequate drainage, stormwater retention and erosion control measures, including but not limited to, silt fence, rock checks and/or wood mulch.
- Install safety fence around the excavations.
- Slope the banks and otherwise guard excavations to prevent caving or sliding banks.
- Protect wetlands, floodplains, shorelands, public waters and other natural features to the maximum extent possible.
- Properly drain, fill in or level excavations.
- Remove material and debris tracked onto public roadways.
- Provided dust control if requested by the City.
- Where applicable, comply with requirements of MPCA and NPDES Permits.
- Retain and store topsoil and utilize in restoration.
- Site restoration with seed, disc mulch or sod must be completed within one (1) week after completion of the project.
- All site restoration must be completed by October 1st of the year in which the permit was approved.
- Other conditions as required by the City.
